### **FPA-10097 Taymouth Castle**

Scotland's Garden and Landscape Heritage is grateful to be included in the above consultation, the site of which affects Taymouth Castle, included in the Inventory of Gardens and Designed Landscapes in Scotland and therefore assessed by Historic Environment Scotland to be of National significance. In the Inventory assessment the landscape is accorded Outstanding Scenic value owing to its prominence in the glen of the River Tay.

We welcome the clear felling of the commercial forestry on the south slopes of the deer park and the opportunity this presents for the re-establishment of the historic woodland pasture with scattered broadleaved trees, reflecting the 18<sup>th</sup> century designed landscape. Although no details are given in the restocking proposals we assume that, if this area is to be managed by grazing in the future, the necessary measures will be taken to protect the replanting.

We confirm we have no further comments to add.
