**21/0044/PP Partial removal of existing service shed and erection of new single storey printmaking studio. Installation of new air source heat pump: Dumfries House, Dumfries House Estate, Cumnock, East Ayrshire**

Scotland's Garden and Landscape Heritage (SGLH) is grateful to be consulted on the above application which affects the Dumfries House designed landscape, included in the Inventory of Gardens and Designed Landscapes in Scotland and therefore assessed by Historic Environment Scotland to be of National Significance.

We have studied the documents submitted in support of this application and have noted the comments received from West of Scotland Archaeology Service in respect of any remains of the former Leifnorris House, which might have been a concern to us. Whilst the footprint of the proposed building will be considerably larger than the one being replaced, we accept that it will still be subservient to the adjacent Laundry Building and in a screened, secluded location within the designed landscape with minimal visual impact.

We confirm we have no objection to the application and would be grateful to be advised of the outcome in due course.
