Woburn Plot 3, Rowallan Castle Estate, Rowallan Castle Golf Club, Rowallan

Scotland's Garden and Landscape Heritage (SGLH) is grateful to be consulted on the above application which affects the Rowallan designed landscape, included in the Inventory of Gardens and Designed Landscapes in Scotland and therefore assessed by Historic Environment Scotland to be of National Significance.

We note and welcome the amendments to the design undertaken since the withdrawal of application 21/0520/PP – removal of large areas of cladding, reduction in areas of glass in favour of rendered façade, and thus more reflective of the existing housing in this area of the landscape.

We understand that all of the plots in Fairview Cluster A are for self-build dwellings and would hope that these general design principles will be applied to the remaining properties to maintain some visual harmony in this compact, discreet area of the Rowallan designed landscape.

We would be grateful to be advised of the outcome of the application in due course and request to remain included in consultations on planning applications affecting Rowallan and other Inventory and non-Inventory designed landscapes in East Ayrshire.
