Thank you for consulting Scotland's Garden and Landscape Heritage on the above Felling Permission Application, which lies within the Rosneath Designed Landscape. Rosneath was removed from the Inventory of Gardens and Designed Landscapes in Scotland in 2016 as it was no longer considered to meet the criteria set by Historic Environment Scotland for National Significance. However, it can still be assessed as retaining Regional Significance as an historic designed landscape due to its Outstanding Historical Value, together with Some Value for Artistic Interest, Nature Conservation and Scenic contribution to the surrounding area.

We have looked at the information submitted in support of the application and confirm we have no concerns with the clear-felling of Sitka Spruce and welcome restocking with mixed broadleaves through natural regeneration, as being more reflective of the historic planting in the designed landscape.

We have no further comments about this application
